The College of Bishops of the Christian Methodist Episcopal Church, learning of the extreme devastation in Haiti by earthquake on January 12, 2010, calls the membership of the Christian Methodist Episcopal Church to respond in the following ways:

1. Effective immediately, the Tenth Episcopal District will be responsible for coordinating mission teams to work in Haiti. Persons interested in information for mission teams should contact:

2. No later than Sunday, February 14, 2010, Christian Methodist Episcopal Church congregations are asked to receive offerings for the relief of Haiti, writing checks to the Department of Finance and sending them through the offices of the Presiding Bishops;
3. The CME Commission on Emergency Relief will coordinate the distribution of monies raised through this process for the relief of Haiti, determining to whom monies will be distributed for aid in Haiti.
4. Presiding Elders and Pastors of Christian Methodist Episcopal Church congregations are asked during this time to also place special emphasis upon teaching more about the life and needs of Haiti, and to lead congregations in study and prayer for Haiti.


