# THE LIFE AND TIMES OF JESSIE CALDWELL, JR.

Jessie Caldwell, Jr. was born on December 6, 1942 to the Late Mary White Caldwell and the Late Jesse Caldwell, Sr. in Albany, Georgia.

He received his public education in the Dougherty County School System, and in June 1960, Jessie was graduated from Holsey-Cobb Institute, Cordele, Georgia.

Later, he enlisted in the United States Air Force in law enforcement. His distinguished military service includes the racial desegregation of the Little Rock, Arkansas school system, two combat tours in Vietnam and special assignments to the U.S. Air Force Academy, Colorado Springs, Colorado. He was one of the few first appointed as sky martial in an effort to stop airplane high jacking.

His professional career in law enforcement spanned more than three decades. In 2003, at the rank of Captain, Jessie retired as Police Chief, Georgia Department of Agriculture, State Farmer’s Market.

Jessie later returned to Albany to care for his mother and renewed his religious roots from childhood with the Hines Memorial Christian Methodist Episcopal Church under Pastor Kenneth D. McMillian. He served faithfully in the church until his illness.

On Saturday, September 19, 2009, Jessie departed this life and leaves to mourn his children: Rodney Caldwell (Teresa), Decatur, Georgia, LaDacia Caldwell, Washington, D.C., Joel Caldwell, Albany, Georgia, Lois Lee, Hampton, Georgia and Allison Henry (Stafford), Huntsville, Alabama; two brothers: Henry Caldwell, Albany, Georgia and Aaron Caldwell (LaVerne), Ellenwood, Georgia; two sisters: Sammi Harewood, Albany, Georgia and Girdine Caldwell, Jonesboro, Georgia; four grandchildren: Llonisha, Casey, Ryann, and Allyson. Also cherishing his memory is a host of nephews, nieces, cousins, and friends.
