WHAT JESUS' FOLLOWERS MUST DO

(Mark 16.14-18; Luke 24.36-49; John 20.19-23; Acts 1.6-8)

16Jesus' eleven disciples went to a mountain in Galilee, where Jesus had told them to meet him. **17**They saw him and worshiped him, but some of them doubted.

18Jesus came to them and said:

I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth! **19**Go to the people of all nations and make them my disciples. Baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, **20**and teach them to do everything I have told you. I will be with you always, even until the end of the world.

LIFE AMONG THE LORD'S FOLLOWERS

42They spent their time learning from the apostles, and they were like family to each other. They also broke bread [\[d\]](#) and prayed together.

43Everyone was amazed by the many miracles and wonders that the apostles worked. **44**All the Lord's followers often met together, and they shared everything they had. **45**They would sell their property and possessions and give the money to whoever needed it. **46**Day after day they met together in the temple. They broke bread [\[d\]](#) together in different homes and shared their food happily and freely, **47**while praising God. Everyone liked them, and each day the Lord added to their group others who were being saved.
