THE CALL TO WORSHIP

LEADER: GLAD SONGS OF VICTORY RING OUT IN THE TENTS OF THE RIGHTEOUS.

PEOPLE: **"THE RIGHT HAND OF THE LORD DOES VALIANTLY; THE RIGHT HAND OF THE LORD IS EXALTED."**

REDEEM US BY THE BLOOD OF YOUR SON, TRANSFORM US BY THE POWER OF YOUR WORD, AND ENABLE US BY THE INDWELLING OF YOUR SPIRIT TO LIVE AS CHILDREN OF LIGHT. FOR ALL OF THIS, WE ASK CONFIDENTLY AND RECEIVE HUMBLY BECAUSE OF YOUR UNCHANGING FAITHFULNESS THROUGH JESUS CHRIST, OUR LORD WHO LIVES AND REIGNS FOR EVERMORE. AMEN.

THE LESSON FROM THE NEW TESTAMENT

MARK 10.46-52

⁴⁶Jesus and his disciples went to Jericho. ⁴⁶As they were leaving, they were followed by a large crowd. A blind beggar by the name of Bartimaeus son of Timaeus was sitting beside the road. ⁴⁷When he heard that it was Jesus from Nazareth, he shouted, "Jesus, Son of David, ^[1] have pity on me!" ⁴⁸Many people told the man to stop, but he shouted even louder, "Son of David, have pity on me!" ⁴⁹Jesus stopped and said, "Call him over!" They called out to the blind man and said, "Don't be afraid! Come on! He is calling for you." ⁵⁰The man threw off his coat as he jumped up and ran to Jesus. ⁵¹Jesus asked, "What do you want me to do for you?" The blind man answered, "Master, ^[1] I want to see!" ⁵²Jesus told him, "You may go. Your eyes are healed because of your faith." Right away the man could see, and he went down the road with Jesus.
