*“You are the salt of the earth”* is one of the few familiar sayings which actually has a spiritual basis. The first harvest of salt dates back to 6000 B.C., and Jesus first spoke it in His Sermon on the Mount. While we know that salt is actually composed of sodium chloride, we do not know how it originally came into existence. Scientists and the rest of the world may be unaware of its origin, but we know that it is another of God's creations for the comfort of mankind.

Having attended Selma University, she was graduated from Albany State College where she prepared to ignite the minds of hundreds of children for 30+ years in the classroom.

Recognizing and accepting Jesus as her Source and knowing the need for having a place (a family) to regularly “trim” her light, she affiliated with the Hines Memorial Christian Methodist Episcopal Church where she sang in the choir and was an active missionary-- frequently serving as décor chairman for the annual Golden Age Luncheon. During the recent days when her mobility was limited, her light did not cease to shine. She coordinated the activities of the Committee on Ministry from her home where she spent much time calling members to inform them of sickness or death in the church family and ordering flowers, fruit baskets, and requesting checks from the treasurer to be sent to the members and families of those in the church who faced adversity. She shined brightly from her home via telephone- still illuminating the lives of friends, former students, and especially the Hines Memorial Church Family.

Even though she has made her transition to a place where we cannot now see her, she will continue to shine in the lives of her brother and sister-in-law, Adrian and Linda Goldston, her sister, Mary Charles Goldston, her niece, Adrianna Goldston, a special friend, Diane Lyons, several godchildren, many loving friends, and her Hines Memorial Family.
